

Screening for Preschool Peer Models

The Cloverleaf Local Schools will be holding “peer model screenings” on

Friday, March 12th

for the 2010-2011 school year at Lodi Primary.

Morning Session: 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

Afternoon Session: 12:30 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.

Screenings are available for children who will be **4** years of age by ***October 1, 2010***.

During our screening process, parents will be required to complete a questionnaire while the prospective students participate in activities throughout the classroom environment.

While in the classroom, each student’s cognitive, motor, social, and communication skills will be observed. There will also be a short assessment designed to evaluate pre-academic skills.

Ideal peer models must have ***strong*** communication and social skills to be eligible to attend the program during the 2010-2011 school year.

The 2010-2011 Preschool year will start the day after Labor Day. The program is currently held four days per week, Monday-Thursday, according to the District’s school calendar.

Both morning (9:00-11:45 a.m.) and afternoon (1:00-3:20 p.m.) classroom slots will be available for eligible students.

Anticipated tuition costs for attending Peer Models will be \$100.00 per month.
